The IAPA Innovative Technology Prize

This important award is designed to recognise an individual, team or company that has made a significant contribution to enhance the safety and productivity of aerial work platforms, over the last 12 months.

The award is designed to focus attention on a physical product that will have a meaningful impact on the industry, possibly across multiple equipment types, and particularly in the context of safety, either for operators of equipment or those who come into contact with access equipment. Innovations that are not specifically safety-related but mark a step-change in productivity will also be considered. Digital innovations should be entered in the new **Digital Development Award** category.

Over the past 50 years aerial work platforms have dramatically improved levels of safety for people working at height. Judges will be looking for technical developments that make a significant leap forward in further enhancing aerial work platforms. This category was introduced last year in response to an initiative by JLG Industries, who suggested that the industry would benefit from an award acknowledging a significant technological innovation or 'breakthrough' that would enhance safety, analogous to the various enhancements seen in the automotive industry.

When compiling your entry, remember that the judges will be reviewing more than 100 submissions. Try to make your presentation as clear as possible, emphasising the most important elements of your entry. (Entries should be no more than 1,500 words)
